

# MINOR IN COMMUNICATION

## ABOUT THIS MINOR

A Minor in Communication introduces the theories and research methods in the field, while allowing students to select from a wide range of courses to explore their interests. Students take two core courses (Principles of Communication and Communication Inquiry), one theory course, and three electives. The electives may provide skills (e.g. Public Speaking, Professional Communication), teach content creation (e.g. Podcasting, Multimedia Storytelling), or focus on other areas of interest (e.g. Political Communication, Family Communication, Gender).

## ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Students must complete a minimum of 18 credit hours, maintain a 2.25 GPA across all Communication courses taken at CSU and successfully complete COM 101 and COM 303 with a minimum grade of a C.

## COURSE REQUIREMENTS

### CORE COURSES (6 credits):

- COM 101 - Principles of Communication
- COM 102 - Adobe Content Creation: Digital Content in Communication

### COMMUNICATION ELECTIVES

#### (12 credits):

- Select 4 additional COM courses from the course offerings provided in CampusNet.

Some COM courses used to fulfill these requirements can also fulfill requirements in the Health Communication Minor, Digital Content Production Minor, and the Communication Skills Certificate.

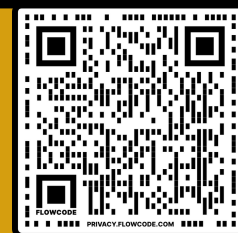
