8 Hour Hazardous Materials NON-Permit Required Confined Space Entry

Course Description:

This course will provide students the knowledge, skill, and materials to be certified as a "Confined Space Entrant and/or Attendant." The course requirements are based upon the OSHA 29 CFR Part 1910.146, "Permit Required Confined Spaces" program. Participants will learn to identify confined spaces, evaluate the hazards, and review proper entry permit requirements for a confined space. Successful completion of the course is based on classroom participation.

Course Objectives:

- Leading cause of death from confined space accidents
- Four causes of death from confined space accidents
- Applicability of OSHA 29 CFR Part 1910.146, "Permit Confined Spaces," to both government and private industry
- Attendant, Authorized Entrant, Entry
- Not permitted condition
- Permit required confined spaces -- Requirements of OSHA 29 CFR Part 1910.146, "Permit Confined Spaces"
- Hazard reduction and monitoring techniques
- Rescue techniques, including rescue protocols, communications, victim removal, atmospheric monitoring, PPE, hazard assessment, rescuer rehabilitation, and logistical support requirements specific site

Who should attend?

- All members of confined space entry teams
- Emergency Response Team (ERT)
- Employees expected to rescue a worker from a confined space without making entry
- Supervisory and Safety Personnel
- Hazardous Waste Site Workers

Earned Credentials:
