

24 Hour OSHA Hazardous Material HAZWOPER Technician

Course Description:

This 24-hour course is for employees who are expected to take offensive and defensive measures to help stop the spread of a chemical spill or to assist in isolating an area until a cleanup contractor arrives. The course requirements are based upon the (OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120 for private sector) and (NFPA for public sector) programs. There is a hands-on practical application section and a written review. This program is designed for initial training and meets the applicable OSHA & NFPA annual refresher requirements.
