Public service is the backbone of both the professional and private life of this year's award recipient, Steven A. Minter, Director of The Cleveland Foundation. Since 1960 the theme of his public service career has been an unwavering dedication to improve and enhance the quality of life for all people. Over the years he has worked with public and private agencies and organizations administering income maintenance, employment services, social services, education programs, neighborhood development activities and criminal justice, with major positions as director of the Cuyahoga County Welfare Department, commissioner of Public Welfare for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and under secretary of the United States Department of Education. He has also been affiliated, often in a leadership capacity, with many corporations, colleges, and public policy organizations such as the American Public Welfare Association, the National Commission for the International Year of the Child, the Child Welfare League of America, the Cleveland Mayor's Commission on Crisis in Welfare, the Council on Foundations and the Independent Sector.
