Steven LaTourette has represented Northeast Ohio in the U.S. House of Representatives since 1995, serving 22 cities, 34 villages and 63 townships in the 14th District, which includes all of Lake, Geauga and Ashtabula counties, and part of Cuyahoga, Summit, Trumbull and Portage counties. He is stepping down from office at the end of the year.

Widely respected and known for his fierce commitment to issues affecting Northeast Ohio, he is credited with helping to save thousands of jobs for the region and bringing tens of millions of federal dollars back to both the district and region.

Prior to his election to the House of Representatives, Congressman LaTourette served from 1989 to 1995 as the Lake County Prosecutor. In 1990, he was named Prosecuting Attorney of the Year in Ohio. A graduate of the University of Michigan and Cleveland-Marshall College of Law, he lives in Bainbridge Township and is the father of six children.
